HONOREES



Norbert Leo Butz

Norbert Leo Butz is a two-time Tony Award winner for Best Actor in a Musical, and is one of only nine actors ever to have won the award twice as lead actor. He first won for his work in *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels* and won again for *Catch Me if You Can*. He was additionally nominated for a Tony for *Thou Shalt Not* and *My Fair Lady*. The star of 11 Broadway shows, he is also a five-time Drama Desk nominee and two-time winner, among other stage accolades.

On television, Butz most recently starred in FX's *Justified* reboot, and has previously starred in Hulu's *The Girl from Plainville*, David Zabel

and Ridley Scott's *Mercy Street* on PBS, *Bloodline* on Netflix, as "Paddy Chayefsky" on *Fosse/Verdon* for FX, and *Debris* for NBC.

Films include the recent *Exorcist: Believer*, Sean Penn's *Flag Day*, Peter Hedges' *Dan in Real Life*, *Higher Ground* opposite and directed by Vera Farmiga, Craig Zisk's *The English Teacher*, *Better Living Through Chemistry* opposite Sam Rockwell, and the recent indie comedy *Give or Take*.

He received a BFA and Honorary Doctorate from Webster University and an MFA from Alabama Shakespeare Theatre.

Alan Cumming

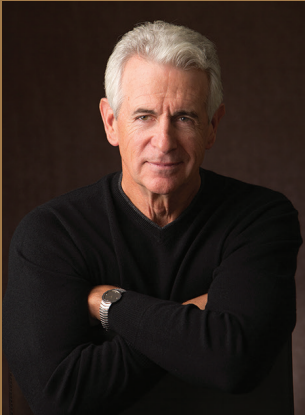
Alan Cumming is beyond eclectic. His most recent projects include hosting a reality competition show called *The Traitors*, creating a solo dance theatre piece about the Scottish bard Robert Burns, lip-synching the protagonist in a documentary, touring internationally with two cabaret shows, directing a podcast series, recording a duet with a Gaelic rapper, and playing diverse characters such as Sigmund Freud, a gangster opposite Liam Neeson in a Neil Jordan film, and an elderly woman with a pet crab in a Disney kids series! Perhaps not surprisingly, *Time Magazine* called him one of the three most fun people in show business (the others were Cher and Stanley Tucci!)

Thirty years ago, his Hamlet stormed the West End and he was hailed as "an actor knocking at the door of greatness." A quarter of a century ago, he was a sensation as *Cabaret's* Master of Ceremonies in a production that forever changed the Broadway landscape. A decade ago, his visceral, virtually one-man *Macbeth* was a stunning, transatlantic coup de theatre. His screen work ranges from art house to blockbuster, cult to mainstream, but his performances are always indelible and some immortal: Eli in *The Good Wife*, Nightcrawler in *X2: X Men United*, Sebastian in *The High Life*, 'O' in *Sex and the City*, Boris in *Goldeneye*, King James in *Doctor Who*, Sandy Frink in *Romy and Michele's High School Reunion*, Mayor Menlove in *Schmigadoon*, and himself in *Broad City*.

He is the author of six books including a *New York Times* #1 bestselling memoir, performs in concert regularly in halls around the world and co-owns his own, eponymous cabaret bar, Club Cumming, a home for "all ages, all genders, all colours, all sexualities, where kindness is all and anything could happen!" The list of his collaborators over the years includes Liza Minnelli, Jackie Chan, The Smurfs, David Bowie, The Simpsons, Stanley Kubrick, Jay-Z, Spice Girls, George Lucas, Dora the Explorer, Arthur, and Elmo. He had a photo exhibition named Alan Cumming Snaps! and an award-winning fragrance named Cumming. He has played Dionysus, the Devil, God, the Pope, and was shot by Herb Ritts for *Vanity Fair* as Pan. He recently played a 70-year-old woman. He has been a Lee Jeans model and featured as part of PETA's Vegetarian Icon stamp series. He is a Tony and Olivier award-winning theatre actor. He hosted the Tonys and was nominated for an Emmy for doing so.

In fact, he has been nominated for five Emmys, won a New York Emmy, a Scottish BAFTA, and a British Comedy Award. He is an Independent Spirit award-winning producer and National Board of Review winning director. He is a Grammy and multiple Golden Globe nominee. His portrait was hung in the Scottish National Portrait Gallery. He has four honorary doctorates and over 40 awards for being a humanitarian, but as he says, "awards mean nothing!"

HONOREES



James Naughton

From Broadway and regional theater to television and films, James Naughton has won critical acclaim in dramas, comedies, and musicals. He is the winner of two Tony Awards as Best Actor in a Musical, for his portrayal of media-savvy lawyer Billy Flynn in the Broadway hit *Chicago* and for his role as a film-noir era detective in *City of Angels*, which also earned him a Drama Desk Award. He won the 1999 MAC Award as best male vocalist for his one-man concert show, *Street of Dreams*, presented by Mike Nichols, and recorded his album, *It's About Time*, for DRG records. In 2014, he recorded his Live From

Lincoln Center Special for PBS, *James Naughton Sings Randy Newman*.

Naughton made his New York debut in Eugene O'Neill's *Long Day's Journey Into Night* with Robert Ryan and Geraldine Fitzgerald, winning immediate recognition with Theatre World, New York Drama Critics, and Vernon Rice Awards. His Broadway credits also include *Democracy*, *Whose Life Is It Anyway*, and *I Love My Wife*.

He directed two critically acclaimed Broadway productions: Arthur Miller's *The Price*, which was nominated for a Tony, and Thornton Wilder's *Our Town* starring Paul Newman, which he also shot for Showtime. He has directed extensively in the Berkshires and in Westport, and played Off-Broadway and in regional theaters for decades.

Naughton's film credits include *Equity*, *Factory Girl*, *The Devil Wears Prada*, *First Wives Club*, *The Glass Menagerie*, *The Good Mother*, *The Paper Chase*, and *Cat's Eye*. On television, he starred in *Planet of the Apes*, *Who's The Boss?*, *Brooklyn Bridge*, *Making the Grade*, *Ally McBeal*, *Damages*, *Gossip Girl*, *Hostages*, and most recently, *And Just Like That*, *Blue Bloods*, *The Blacklist*, and *The Affair*. He has recorded many books on tape and more than a few voice-overs.

has starred on Broadway in the title role of Rodgers and Hammerstein's *Cinderella*, *Baby It's You* and *Pipe Dream* in New York City Center's Encore series.

Off-Broadway, she starred as Lady Larken in *Once Upon a Mattress* with the Transport Group. She has starred in various productions around the country and performed at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Birdland, Bucks County Playhouse, Caramoor, Feinstein's/54 Below, and Jones Hall with the Houston Symphony.

Santino Fontana

received the 2019 Tony Award for his tour de force dual performance in *Tootsie*. He's also received two Drama Desk Awards, an Outer Critics Circle Award, Lortel Award, Obie Award, and Clarence Derwent Award in a mix of straight plays and musicals. Theater credits include *Hello Dolly*, *Act One*, *Cinderella*, and *The Importance of Being Earnest*. He is perhaps best known for lending his voice to Prince Hans in Disney's *Frozen*. An interpreter of the American Songbook, he has sung with the New York Philharmonic, New York Pops, Westchester Philharmonic, Mormon Tabernacle Choir, Sesame Street Muppets, Phoenix Symphony, and at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, The Kennedy Center, and more.

Shereen Pimentel

Shereen Pimentel will join past Music Conservatory honoree André De Shields as a lead in this summer's Perelman Performing Arts Center (PAC NYC) Cats: *The Jellicle Ball*, a reimagining of the musical by Andrew Lloyd Webber based on *Old Possum's Book of Practical Cats* by T.S. Eliot. She was last seen as Eva Perón in American Repertory Theatre & Shakespeare Theatre Company's co-production of *Evita*. She starred in the 2020 Broadway revival of *West Side Story* as Maria for which she was recognized as an Outer Critics Circle honoree for Best Actress in a musical. Her other credits include Young Nala in *The Lion King* on Broadway, Guenevere in *Camelot* at The

Muny, and New York City Center's Encores! production of *Into the Woods* as Rapunzel. Her screen credits include *John Mulaney & the Sack Lunch Bunch* on Netflix. Shereen is a graduate from the Juilliard School with a bachelor's degree in vocal performance.

The Music Therapy Institute offers music therapy and adapted instruction for children and adults with disabilities. Using the intrinsic qualities of music, our board-certified therapists design an individualized program to meet the needs of each student. Our program is the largest professional provider in the Westchester region. In addition to our on-site program, our Outreach Program provides music therapy in partnership with 28 school districts, special education schools, medical facilities, hospice, and social services.



The Healing Our Heroes program serves U.S. Military Veterans with combat-related injuries. Healing Our Heroes offers music therapy and instrumental instruction to assist in coping with physical pain, stress, and anxiety. Since 2013, our life-changing program has reached more than 50 veterans, providing them with free services.

The Scholarship Program provides tuition assistance for students of all ages to help them achieve their musical dreams and reach their full potential regardless of financial circumstances. Our community music school empowers students with the tools to develop their creative potential, strengthen academic performance, and provide inspiration to pursue higher education opportunities.
