Honoree

DES McANUFF



Des McAnuff is a distinguished theater and film director and producer, celebrated for his innovative contributions and has received two Tony Awards. As the former artistic director of Canada's Stratford Festival and Director Emeritus of La Jolla Playhouse, he directed over 30 diverse productions, ranging from classics to new plays and musicals. His work at La Jolla Playhouse underscored his versatility and creativity.

McAnuff's Broadway credits are extensive including *The Who's Tommy* in 2024 and its 1993 original production, which won him a Tony Award for Best Direction of a Musical. Other credits include *Big River*, which won the Tony Award for Best Musical, *Jersey Boys*, which won Tony and Olivier Awards for Best Musical, *Billy Crystal's 700 Sundays*, earning a Tony Award for Best Special Theatrical Event, *Ain't Too Proud: The Life and Times of The Temptations*, *Guys and Dolls*, *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying*, *Summer: The Donna Summer Musical*, *Dracula, the Musical*, and *The Farnsworth Invention*.

Beyond the stage, McAnuff's influence extends to opera and film. He directed *Faust* at The Met and *ENO* and directed *Cousin Bette* in film. He produced the film *The Iron Giant*, which won a BAFTA Award. His television work includes the HBO adaptation of *700 Sundays*.

In recognition of his significant impact on the arts, McAnuff received an honorary doctorate from Ryerson University in 2011. In 2012, he was appointed to the Order of Canada and received Canada's Governor General's National Arts Center Award.

Honoree

RUFUS WAINWRIGHT



Praised by the *New York Times* for his "genuine originality," **Rufus Wainwright** has established himself as one of the great male vocalists, songwriters, and composers of his generation. The New York-born, Montreal-raised singer-songwriter has released ten studio albums to date, three DVDs, and three live albums including the Grammy-nominated *Rufus Does Judy at Carnegie Hall*. He has collaborated with artists including Elton John, Burt Bacharach, Miley Cyrus, David Byrne, Boy George, Joni Mitchell, Heart, Billy Joel, Paul Simon, Sting, and producer Mark Ronson. He has written two operas and numerous songs for movies and TV.

His 2020 studio album of original songs, *Unfollow the Rules*, received a Grammy nomination. In 2023, he embarked on a journey to his family folk roots with his Grammy-nominated album *Folkocracy* featuring reinvented folk duets with artists like Chaka Khan, Brandi Carlile, John Legend and many more.

His first musical of *John Cassavetes' Opening Night for the West End* with Ivo van Hove premiered at the Gielgud Theater in March 2024. During this time he also completed his *Dream Requiem*, which premiered with the Orchestre Philharmonique de Radio France in June of 2024 and featured Meryl Streep as the narrator. The recording of the performance was released via Warner Classics in January 2025, which was followed by the US premiere at the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles featuring Jane Fonda as the narrator.

Your Host

SETH RUDETSKY



Seth Rudetsky has had an extensive career on Broadway as a pianist and conductor, and earned three Emmy nominations as a comedy writer on *The Rosie O'Donnell Show*. Currently, he is the afternoon DJ on the SiriusXM Broadway channel and hosts *Seth Speaks*. Seth has showcased his performance, *Deconstructing Broadway*, in cities like London and Boston—where he won the IRNE award—and Los Angeles, in front of audiences including Barbra Streisand.

Rudetsky, along with his native Texan husband James Wesley, initiated the livestream *Stars In The House* when Broadway went dark. This initiative has successfully raised over \$1.2 million for The Entertainment Community Fund, formerly known as The Actors Fund, and recently marked its three-year milestone.

He co-wrote and starred in *Disaster!* on Broadway, which was selected as a *NY Times* critics' pick and is now licensed by Music Theater International, being performed nationwide. Seth is also an author, having written *Seth's Broadway Diary Volume 1 and 2* as well as two young adult novels: *My Awesome/Awful Popularity Plan* and *The Rise and Fall of a Theater Geek*, both published by Random House, and the recently released *Musical Theatre For Dummies*. Together with James, Seth co-produced the *What The World Needs Now Is Love* recording with Broadway Records, which topped iTunes charts, featuring renowned singers like Jessie Mueller, Carole King, Audra MacDonald, and Lin-Manuel Miranda, to support the victims and families of the Orlando Pulse Nightclub shooting.

Honoree

LESLIE UGGAMS



Leslie Uggams is a renowned Tony and Emmy Award-winning actress and singer, celebrated for her dynamic career spanning over seven decades. Known for her powerful role in the groundbreaking TV mini-series *Alex Haley's Roots*, she earned a Critics Choice Award, and both Emmy and Golden Globe nominations. Uggams illustrious career began at just nine years old at New York's Apollo Theater, where she opened for legends like Louis Armstrong and Ella Fitzgerald.

Leslie's Broadway debut in *Hallelujah, Baby!* earned her Tony and Theater World Awards. Other notable Broadway performances include *Blues in the Night*, *Anything Goes*, and *King Headley II*, which earned her another Tony nomination. Off-Broadway, she received Audelco Awards for her performances in *The Old Settler* and *Thunder Knocking on the Door*.

Her one-woman musical, *Uptown/Downtown*, won multiple awards, including the LA Drama Critics Circle Award and NAACP Theatre Award. She made history as the first African American actress to portray Mama Rose in *Gypsy* at the Connecticut Repertory Theatre. Her screen credits include *Deadpool*, *American Fiction* and TV series like *Empire* and *The Gilded Age*.

In addition to her theatrical achievements, Uggams has released numerous albums and performed with symphony orchestras, gracing venues such as the Hollywood Bowl and the U.S. Capitol's Memorial Day Concert. Her legacy is cemented with numerous honors, including membership in the Theater Hall of Fame and various lifetime achievement awards.
